SHIPPING ENVIRONMENTAL SAMPLES

Shipping environmental samples is considered the most difficult type of submission due to the required temperature range and viability restrictions.

- **Elevated Temperatures** When an environmental sample is received at a temperature of >10°C, it is considered compromised by NQAC Dublin's integrity definition. To prevent this issue from occurring, sufficient ice packs will be needed to keep the swab samples cool during the shipping process.
- **Frozen Swabs** when environmental swab samples are received < 0°C or frozen to the touch, the samples are also considered compromised. *To avoid environmental samples becoming frozen, plastic bubble wrap or cardboard can be used to separate samples from direct contact with the ice packs.*
